<u>Trip Checklist</u> (Things to Remember)

Dress is casual and comfortable for all activities. Please pack only in the Honor Flight bag we have given you. Do not have any bags that need to be checked.

- 1. All medications (HFCCC doesn't assist with medications) Please pack 3 extra days of medications.
- 2. If you have a DNR, please bring a copy to the airport & place it in your lanyard
- 3. Comfortable walking shoes
- 4. Sunglasses
- 5. Camera, phone and charger
- 6. Military hat if you have one
- 7. Honor Flight jacket & T-shirts
- 8. Any sort of memorabilia you would like to bring
- 9. Money for souvenirs (HFCCC pays for everything else)
- 10. Any updated medical information
- 11.Government Issued ID for airport

Transportation Security Administration (TSA) Carry-On Requirements

Air travelers may carry a Zip-Lock bag with liquids, gels and aerosols in their carry-on bag when going through security checkpoints.



The following rules apply to all liquids, gels and aerosols you want to carry through a security checkpoint (with certain exceptions as noted). YOU MAY BRING PRESCRIPTION MEDICATIONS IN YOUR CARRY-ON.

- All liquids, gels and aerosols, with the exception of liquid medications, must be in 3.4 ounce (100ml) or smaller containers. Larger containers that are half-full or toothpaste tubes rolled up are not allowed. Each container must be 3.4 ounces (100ml) or smaller. For the Veterans, we have travel toothpaste and shaving cream available, pick it up when you get your flight bag.
- All liquids, gels and aerosols must be placed in a single, quart-size, zip-top, clear plastic bag. Gallon size bags or bags that are not zip-top such as fold-over sandwich bags are not allowed.
